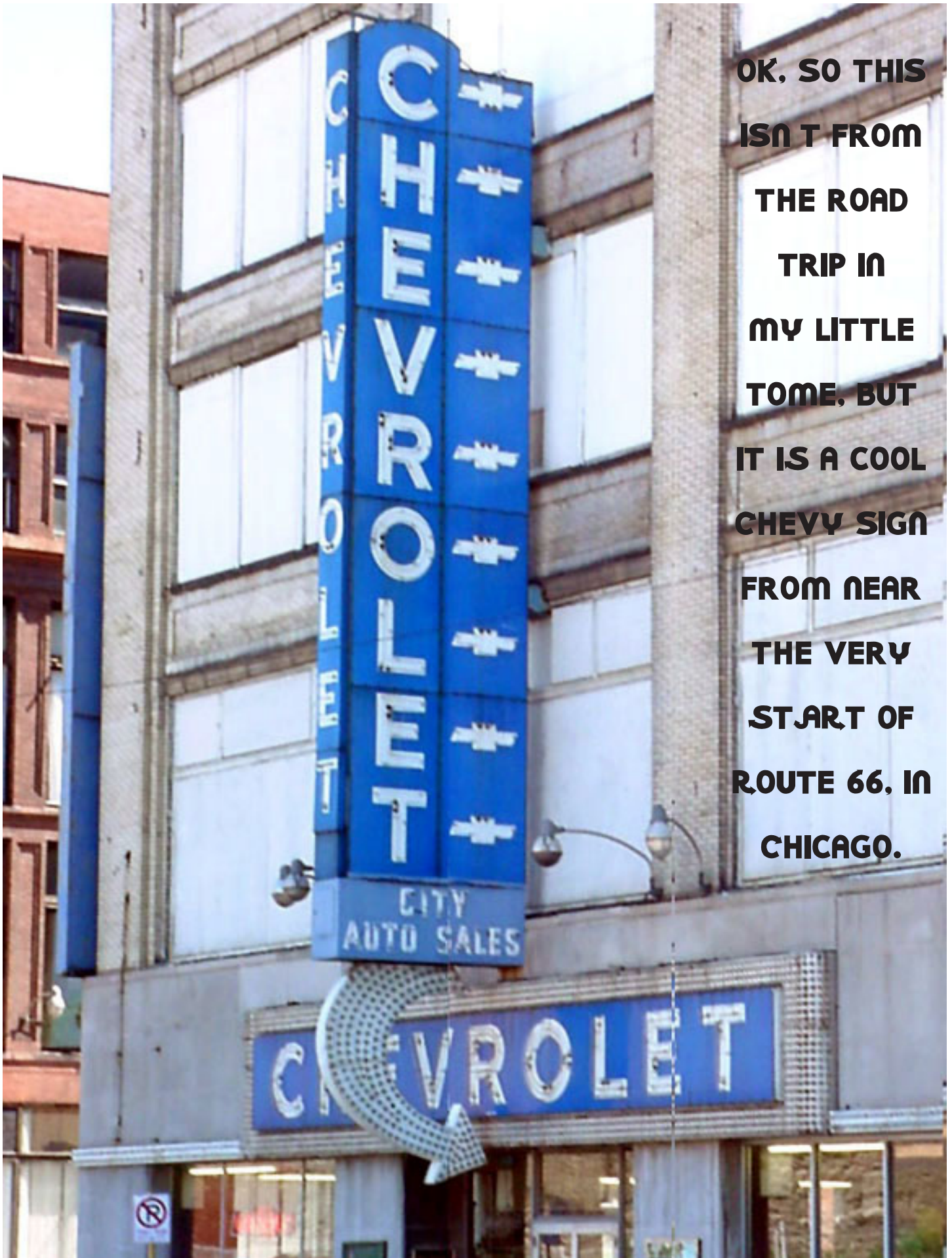
LEFT:
